Alabama	Banned	<p>SB 267 prohibits state and local governments from issuing vaccine passports, passes, or any other standardized documentation for the purpose of certifying the immunization status of an individual. It also prohibits institutions of education from requiring additional vaccines (COVID-19) as a condition of attendance. It also prohibits individuals or entities doing business from refusing to provide goods or services, or refusing admission into a place of business, if a customer does not have documentation to prove they have been vaccinated.</p>	No
Alaska	Banned	<p>Governor's Administrative Order prohibits all executive branch departments, agencies, officials, and state entities from requiring a person to produce a vaccine passport in order to travel to or around Alaska</p>	<p>MyIR - provides printed and mobile vaccination records</p>
Arizona	Banned	<p>Executive Order prohibits state and local governments from requiring individuals to provide their COVID-19 vaccination status to receive service or enter an area. Also prohibits businesses receiving public funds from Arizona from requiring customers to provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination.</p> <p>SB 1824 prohibits the establishment of a COVID-19 passport, among other things</p>	<p>MyIR - provides printed and mobile vaccination records</p>

California	Not banned	In San Francisco , all restaurants, bars, clubs, gyms and large indoor events will be required to obtain proof of vaccination from patrons and employees. Individuals can show proof of negative COVID test	Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record Portal - California Department of Public Health and Technology launched the Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record portal, which allows residents to upload a digital copy of their vaccination records Healthvana - digital vaccine record for residents of LA county

The bill also withholds state grants and contracts from local governments or businesses that require customers to prove they have received the COVID-19 vaccine.	No
Kansas	Banned	SB 159 prohibits state agencies from issuing a COVID-19 vaccination passport to any individual without such individual's consent or requiring an individual to use a COVID-19 vaccination passport within the state for any purpose.	No

The order also prohibits businesses from requiring customers to provide proof of vaccination to enter or receive services from a business. HB 702 prohibits discrimination based on vaccination status or whether the person has an immunity passport.	No

<p>North Carolina</p>	<p>Not banned</p>		<p>North Carolina COVID-19 Vaccine Portal - if you received your COVID-19 vaccine from a North Carolina doctor's office, independent pharmacy, your local health department or community event, and you provided your email address, you may be able to access your vaccination record.</p>
<p>North Dakota</p>	<p>Banned</p>	<p>HB 1465 prohibits a state government entity or any of its subdivisions, agents, or assigns from requiring documentation, whether physical or electronic, for the purpose of certifying or otherwise communicating an individual's vaccination status; the presence of pathogens, antigens, or antibodies; or an individual's post-transmission recovery status before providing access to state property, funds, or services. Also prohibits private business from requiring a patron or customer to provide any documentation certifying vaccination or post transmission recovery to gain access to, entry upon, or services from the business. This does not apply to health care providers, including a long-term care provider.</p>	<p>MyIR - provides printed and mobile vaccination records</p>

Oklahoma	Banned	<p>SB 658 prohibits a board of education of a public school district or a technology center school district, the board of regents of an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the governing board of a private postsecondary educational institution, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the State Board of Education or the State Board of Career and Technology Education from requiring a vaccine passport as a condition of admittance to or attendance of the school or institution.</p> <p>Executive Order prohibits state agencies from requiring that people show proof of vaccination to enter public buildings. The order doesn't apply to employees and buildings of state agencies that are primarily involved in medical patient-facing activities.</p>	OSIIS - provides viewable vaccination records that individuals can download and print

<p>Tennessee</p>	<p>Banned</p>	<p>SB 858 prohibits state or local governmental officials, entities, departments, or agencies from requiring, or mandating that private businesses require, physical documentation or digital storage of protected health information related to an individual's immunization or vaccination against COVID-19 as a condition of entering upon the premises of a state or local government entity or private business, or utilizing services provided by a state or local government entity or private business.</p>	<p>No</p>
<p>Texas</p>	<p>Banned</p>	<p>Executive Order prohibits state agencies or political subdivisions in Texas from creating a "vaccine passport" requirement, or otherwise conditioning receipt of services on an individual's COVID-19 vaccination status. The order also prohibits organizations receiving public funds from requiring consumers to provide documentation of vaccine status in order to receive any service or enter any place.</p> <p>SB 968 prohibits governmental entities from issuing vaccine passports to certify an individual's COVID-19 vaccination status to a third party for a purpose other than health care. Also prohibits businesses from requiring customers to provide documentation certifying the customer's COVID-19 vaccination on entry to, to gain access to, or to receive service from the business.</p>	<p>No</p>
