### Back to Campus this Fall

#1. Which comes closer to what your institution’s work environment will likely be this Fall for faculty and staff? (Single Choice)


Nearly all faculty/staff will return to campus for face-to-face work. We have no plans for reassessing this model. 15%




Nearly all faculty/staff will return to campus for face-to-face work. We will assess hybrid/remote work over the Fall. 39%



Some faculty/staff will return to campus; some will work remotely or have a hybrid work environment. 45%




Nearly all faculty/staff will work remotely or have a hybrid work environment. 2%



### Pulse of the Leadership

#1. Which best characterizes your leadership’s post-pandemic approach to a return to work for faculty and staff this fall? (Single Choice)

a) We have a “back-to-normal” approach, where we are striving to return everyone to work as they were pre-pandemic (i.e., those who were working on campus will return to working on campus). 27%



b) Our approach is something in between these but closer to “a”. 30%



c) Our approach is something in between these but closer to “d”. 16%
